TOURNAMENT CREDIT POLICY

Following is the policy for tournament credit, how it may be used, and when it should be used. This policy will be in force for the 2010 golf season. Please read and understand it. Your understanding will assist in avoiding any awkward situation.

Tournament credit earned during the 2010 golf season will be handled in two ways:

- ✦ All Tournament Credit expires on **November 30, 2010** No exceptions.
- ✦ Tournament credit may be used for golf merchandise only or special orders, special orders are subject to retail pricing and shipping charges.
- ✦ Tournament Credit will be applied to purchases at the time and may not be accumulated.
- ✦ Tournament Credit **MAY NOT** be used to purchase gift certificates.
- ✦ **Tournament Credit is non-transferable and may only be used by owner.**

I believe this is fair and equitable for all parties. Any concerns or questions should be brought to my attention as soon as possible.

REMINDERS

Tournament Eligibility:

- ◆ Entrant must be a member in good standing of the Derryfield Country Club Associates (paid dues for 2010) and maintain a handicap at the Derryfield Country Club.
- ◆ Unless otherwise posted, the deadline for sign-up will be 4:00 PM the Wednesday prior to the tournament.
- ◆ All entries will be on a first come, first served basis, where tee times, flights, or limited entries are involved. You may sign up your twosome or foursome by paying tournament fee in full.
- ◆ All Tournaments will use the player's current handicap as of the start date of the tournament. Every effort will be made to obtain updated handicaps for seeding players into their proper flight. Ultimately, it is the player's responsibility to know their current handicap.
- ◆ Any issues regarding a tournament or within the responsibilities of the Tournament Committee will be resolved by a quorum of no less than (4) four members of the Tournament Committee.

- ◆ Every member of the Derryfield Country Club associates (the back room) is invited and encouraged to participate in all DCCA sponsored tournaments, regardless of their DCCA membership. (Senior membership holders are welcome to play in any DCCA Tournament)
- ◆ To enter a tournament, present the required entry fee at the Pro Shop. Clearly stipulate the tournament you wish to enter as there will be multiple tournament registrations occurring simultaneously.
- ◆ Member/Guest entries: Note that **every guest** must present a “current” GHIN card the day of the tournament. Guests without cards will play with a zero (0) handicap (scratch). So remind your partner! **NO EXCEPTIONS !!**

POSTED INFORMATION:

- ◆ All tournament information posters will be located on the DCC bulletin boards or in the Pro Shop.
 - ❖ LOCAL RULES: (including preferred lies) will be determined by the Pro Shop and may be posted on the first (1st) tee, in the Pro Shop, and/or on the men’s bulletin boards.
 - ❖ All Weekend tournaments, if any, sponsored by the Derryfield Country Club Pro Shop will be posted in the pro shop. Please sign up BEFORE your round of golf.
 - ❖ Other information, from time to time, may be posted on the men’s bulletin boards, on the web site at www.derryfieldgolf.com, or in the Pro Shop.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ◆ Tournament result winners from the schedule will be sent to the Manchester Union Leader for publication, and will be posted on the web site. All pro shop tournament results will be posted on the bulletin boards by Wednesday following the tournament.
- ◆ All tournament ties will be broken by matching cards from the 18th hole backward unless otherwise specified by the specific Tournament rules.
- ◆ Maximum Playing Handicap for any event is 36.
- ◆ The Tournament Committee reserves the right to establish a tournament handicap for ***any member***.
- ◆ Rain-outs or cancellations of any tournament involving a meal will result in the balance of the entry fee applied to member as Pro Shop credit.
- ◆ Emergency situations will be handled at the discretion of the DCC head golf professional or his designee.
- ◆ Unless specifically noted herein below, any maximum allowable handicap indices shall be determined by current USGA recommendations.

TOURNAMENT TEE TIMES

⇒ Tee times will be granted on a first come, first served basis for all tournaments with starting times that aren't based on flights or round robin matches.

⇒ There are several types of tee times listed in the tournament schedule - as follows:

LOTTERY - Sign up on request form in the Pro Shop by Wednesday evening.
..... Make your own foursome.

SHOTGUN - Every team begins at the same start time, but on a different hole.
(All 18 holes are still played). Teams are established by the Tournament Committee & Pro Shop.

RANGE - All Teams/Players in a tournament will be assigned a start time by the committee within the specified time range. In some cases, you may select your tee time at sign up.

>>>> HANDICAP COMMITTEE REGULATIONS <<<<

The Derryfield Country Club Associates extends a welcome to past and new members to the 2010 Golf season. An extensive tournament schedule has been planned for the season. The cornerstone of your participation in these events is your "handicap".

The United States Golf Association provides member of the Derryfield Country Club Associates the opportunity to secure and maintain a USGA Handicap. The goal is to provide an equal opportunity for all golfers to compete, regardless of ability. Current scores are monitored and a player's handicap index is adjusted as his ability changes. The USGA promotes continuity from one season to another by making handicaps continuous regardless of the winter break. Your Associate dues are based on a one year membership which runs from April 1 of the current year through March 31 of the following year. A new revision schedule has been developed to provide updates and allow posting of scores year round.

The Handicap Committee is charged with the operation of this system at the Derryfield Country Club. As such, its obligation is to see that members post scores in a timely and correct manner. The Committee wants the members to understand their obligations regarding the maintenance of their handicap and be aware that failure to comply with these rules may result in the imposition of penalty scores and handicap adjustments. Repeat offenders will be referred to the Board of Directors which may result in the suspension or revocation of your USGA Handicap Index.

The first rule is very simple. Post all of your 18 hole scores after proper adjustment in accordance with the USGA Equitable Stroke Control procedure. The whole concept of the handicap system is to establish one's current ability to play a round of golf at a certain level.

One of the greatest misunderstandings among golfers is that a handicap index represent a person's average scoring ability. That is incorrect. It is designed to represent your potential ability. That is why it is important that all of your rounds are posted. Only the golfer's ten lowest score differentials are used to determine his potential ability or handicap. High scores, though not directly used, can cause a change in

handicap when eliminating other scores and reflecting an upward trend. Once again, **post all 18 hole and 9 hole scores.**

Tournament scores are cross-checked by the Committee to see if they were correctly posted. This includes Club Tournaments as well as State Four Balls, Pro-Ams and Member-Guest Tournaments at other clubs. **When a tournament, you must post a (T) next to the score.** The purpose of the (T) is to correct the indices of those players who seem to play substantially better or worse in competitions than they do in casual rounds of golf.

The fact that your score was achieved at another golf course should not prevent its timely entry. Most New Hampshire golf courses have a computer terminal where your score can be posted and it will automatically be routed to Derryfield at the next revision. Or it can be posted from any computer with internet access.

The Handicap Committee is also in charge with investigating claims that individuals may be manipulating their scores. Since the premise behind the system is peer review by other members, if there are persons who you know are acting in this manner, it should be reported to the Handicap Committee. It is very frustrating for the Committee to hear complaints that a certain person is a “sandbagger”, but no one comes forward with a direct complaint that the person is engaged in this type of conduct. This conduct may include:

- a. Posting erroneous scores
- b. Stopping play after 12 holes to avoid posting scores
- c. Repeatedly playing more than one ball to avoid posting scores
- d. Not adjusting hole scores under Section 4 of the rules
- e. Deliberately reporting more or fewer strokes than actually scored
- f. Repeatedly taking extra strokes to inflate a score

An important purpose of our committee is to try to level the playing field among all golfers. Many members claim that they do not play in tournaments because it is the same persons who win the net prizes all the time. If we can assure compliance with the posting rules, we will substantially reduce the number of sandbaggers that may exist. If you have any questions regarding the rules or your particular handicap, please feel free to contact us.

- The fee includes breakfast, ***which will be served from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM*** !!!

- Shotgun Start -- Guaranteed BOGEY format

- Sign up early, this tournament fills up quickly. The Pro Shop or Tournament Committee will select the team captain and make each team with 4 players.

- During play, the team shall select the spot from which everyone hits. This is repeated until the ball is holed or the team captain cards the **guaranteed BOGEY** for the hole.

- The captain submits one card for the team with the number of strokes played per hole. Maximum score per hole is BOGEY.

- Ties for each place will be broken by matching cards from the 18th hole backwards.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to establish a tournament handicap for **ANY MEMBER** with less than 5 posted scores.

NOTES:

- ✚ Make up your own team and sign up 30 days prior to the tournament in the Pro Shop
- ✚ Sign up is on a first come first served basis with flights of six teams.
- ✚ **The Pro Shop/Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept any post entries as necessary or limit any entries not making a full flight.**
- ✚ The Tournament Committee will assemble flights of six (6) teams grouped by handicap.
- ✚ The number of groups going out Friday may force the use of the first and tenth tee.
- ✚ Friday's tee position is at the discretion of the Pro Shop.

Format over the three day period:

- ✚ Each team will play a nine hole match with the 5 remaining teams in their flight.
- ✚ The results of all 5 matches are totaled.
- ✚ The first 9 hole match is scheduled for anytime Friday. Matches #2 and #3 are scheduled for Saturday beginning at 8:00 AM.
- ✚ Strokes for each match are based on 90% of the player's home course handicap from the white tees. Players then receive strokes off the low man.
- ✚ No player will be given more than one (1) stroke per hole.

Ties decided by the following rule:

- ✚ First place tie breaker: Head to head with the team with whom you are tied. If a tie still exist then head to head against the third place team and so on until the tie is broken
- ✚ Second place tie breaker: Head to head with the team with whom you are tied. If a tie still exist then head to head with the first place team, if a tie still exist, then fourth and so on until the tie is broken.
- ✚ Third Place tie breaker: Head to head with the team with whom you are tied. If a tie still exists then head to head with the first place team and so on until the tie is broken.

Final tie breaker: best gross score starting from the 18th hole backwards using Sunday's score card.

- ✚ You may sign up for this event beginning March 1st in the golf shop. The deadline for registration is May 27th, 2010.
- ✚ Pairings will be posted on or before May 30th. Your first match should be played on or before June 30th. Your second match should be played on or before July 31st. Your third match should be played on or before August 31st.
- ✚ **Final matches scheduled for September 25th, 2010 ***

[* In the event that you cannot play on September 25th, your final match **must** be played on or before September 30th.]

[** The Last Flight will be awarded strokes at 100% of the difference on the day of the match. All other flights will play at “scratch”.]

You may pick your tee time and pairing for Day One. Pairings for the 2nd day will be based on the team's 1st day's score. Leaders will tee off last.
- ✚ Sign up in the Pro Shop within 30 days of the tournament.
- ✚ Each player will play his own ball through the green and score the following points for each hole:

Eagle = 8 points	Birdie = 4 points
Par = 2 points	Bogey = 1 point
Double bogey = 0 points	

The team's QUOTA, (target score) is calculated as follows:

1. Player 1 and Player 2: subtract **each** player's course handicap from 36
2. Add the results together
3. The goal is to score points in excess of the team's Quota.

EXAMPLE:

Player 1's handicap = 17	$36 - 17 = 19$
Player 2's handicap = 9	$36 - 9 = \underline{27}$
Total Quota: 46	

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to establish a tournament handicap for any member with less than (5) posted scores.

- 🚩 The tournament committee or pro shop will assemble flights of eight (8) players grouped by handicap.
- 🚩 Each entrant will play two 18 hole rounds, recording their strokes for each hole.
- 🚩 The Club Champion will be the participant shooting the lowest gross score of the tournament and can come from **any flight !**
- 🚩 In addition to the Club Champion, the individual 50 years old or older shooting the lowest gross score for the 36 holes will be the Senior Club Champion.
- 🚩 The same person can win both Club Championship and Senior Club Championship awards.
- 🚩 All flights will pay the low gross and two low net scores (40%, 40%, 20%). Champion and Senior Champion receive an additional \$50.00. In the event it is the same player, he will be awarded the \$50.00 additional prize once.
- 🚩 Handicap will be 100% from the Blue Tees Course Rating
- 🚩 The tournament committee reserves the right to accept any post entries as necessary.

**** Any ties for a championship (Club Championship, Senior Club Championship) will be broken by playoff. Playoffs will be played on the 1st and 18th holes until decided.**

**** NOTE: Rain date of August 7th is only if both days above are rained out; otherwise, the Club Championship can be decided by one day's tournament play.**

- ✚ Each player will play his ball through the green.

- 🚩 **The results of the two rounds are then totaled.**

Format:

- 🚩 Each player will play his ball through the green.
- 🚩 Card the better 2 scores for each of the 18 holes, gross and net.

Format:

- 🚩 For the first six holes, card **one best** score of the foursome.
- 🚩 For the second six holes, card the **two best** scores of the foursome.

- 🚩 And finally, for the last hole, card **all four** scores.

Example: Par would be = 146, broken down as follows:

- 🚩 First six holes (4,4,3,4,4,4) = 23
- 🚩 Second six holes (8,6,8,8,8,6) = 44
- 🚩 the next five holes (12,12,12,12,15) = 63
- 🚩 and finally, the last hole (4,4,4,4) = 16
