MEMBERSHIP RULES FOR 2021 PERMIT HOLDERS

Special Rules by Membership Type

Membership Type	Rules
Standard Single/Standard	No tee time restrictions
Family, Young Executive	May reserve tee times up to 14 days in advance
Young Adult, Senior/Senior	Green fees apply to tee times prior to noon on weekends and holidays
Family	May reserve tee times up to 7 days in advance
Junior	Play restricted to Mon – Fri until 3:30 pm, weekends and holidays after noon Must attend etiquette class; may be required to re-take (at Club's discretion) May reserve tee times up to 3 days in advance

General Rules

- 1. Purchases are final. There will be no refunds, credits, or exchanges.
- 2. If necessary to provide access to all members, players may be limited to 18 holes per day.
- 3. The golf course and pro shop will typically open by 7:30 AM on weekdays/6:30 AM on weekends and holidays, and will close at the hours posted. Opening times are subject to available daylight and may be later in fall.
- 4. Season Permits are not transferable. A photo will be taken for proof of identity.
- 5. All players must register at the pro shop before beginning play and will be assigned a tee time if they do not have one already. Players will typically be grouped into threesomes or foursomes.
- 6. Players must follow the directions of the pro shop, starter and/or ranger.
- 7. Each player must have his or her own set of clubs.
- 8. Bringing one's own food or beverages onto the course for consumption or re-sale is prohibited.*
- 9. No player is allowed to play more than one ball at a time.
- 10. Practice is allowed in designated areas only.
- 11. Players are expected to keep pace, use designated tees, replace divots, repair ball marks, and smooth sand traps.
- 12. Players are expected to follow all proper golf etiquette, and to yield to course maintenance personnel.
- 13. Players must wear proper attire:
 - Acceptable footwear are spiked golf shoes or sneakers (no bare feet, and no soccer/football cleats)
 - Acceptable tops are golf shirts; sleeveless shirts must be two inches wide at the shoulder (no tank tops or tee shirts)
 - Bermuda shorts are acceptable (no cut-off shorts)
- 14. Spectators are not allowed on the course except by special permission of management.
- 15. Caddies are allowed but must be identified as such and may not play while caddying.
- 16. Golf bags, pull carts, and golf carts must be kept off tees, greens and aprons. Drivers of golf carts must follow all signs and directions, and keep to paths where provided.
- 17. The golf course may be closed on occasion for tournaments or maintenance.

*Derryfield Country Club has a full-service restaurant, as well as an on-course snack shack and a beverage cart.

I have read and agree to adhere to the rules described above. I understand that violation of these rules may result in the loss of playing time, revocation of golf cart privileges, and/or cancelation of my Season Permit.
