



**POLICY AND PROCEDURES
FOR GOLFERS
including
2017 SEASON PERMIT HOLDERS**

Failure to comply with any of the policies and procedures stated below may result in the loss of playing and/or golf cart privileges.
(See discipline policy on reverse side.)

This facility is available to the public, and in its endeavor to assist and guide participants, the Parks, Recreation & Cemetery Division has adopted the following policies and procedures:

1. **There are no permit refunds, credits, or exchanges. All purchases are final.**
2. All permit holders may be limited to 18 holes per day. Tee Times are required 7 Days a Week.
3. Full Paying Permit Holders may reserve their tee times up to 14 Days in Advance.
Seniors Citizens/College Students - 7 Days
Intermediate (14-17) - 3 Days in Advance.
Juniors (13 and under) - 2 Days in Advance.
4. The Derryfield Country Club Golf Course and golf shop will open each day no later than 7:30 A.M. weekdays, 6:30 A.M. weekends and holidays and close at the hours posted. The season runs from January 1st to December 31st.
5. Current Season Permits are not transferable. A photo will be taken for proof of purchase.
6. Every Season Permit Holder and player **must** register at the Golf Shop before beginning play and will be assigned a tee time if they do not have one already. All players will be grouped into threesomes and/or foursomes. A group of five will be at the discretion of the pro shop. All players must follow the directions of the pro shop, starter and/or ranger and must have their own set of clubs.
7. Derryfield Country Club has a full service restaurant that is open daily and provides a beverage cart on the course for the consumption of food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. The City of Manchester prohibits anyone or any group from bringing their own food, alcoholic, and non-alcoholic beverages onto the golf course for consumption or re-sale.
8. No player is allowed to play more than one ball at any time. Practicing is allowed in designated areas only. All players must play the course in the correct order; no jumping from hole to hole.
9. Players are expected to keep pace on the golf course. Please use designated tees, replace divots, repair ball marks, and smooth sand traps. All players are asked to exercise proper golf etiquette.
10. All players must wear proper attire. Nonmetal spiked golf shoes or sneakers must be worn. No bare feet, no soccer or football cleats. Golf shirts and Bermuda shorts are acceptable. No tank tops, cut off shorts, or tee shirts. Sleeveless shirts should be 2" wide at the shoulder.
11. Spectators are not allowed anywhere on the course except by special permission of the management. Caddies are allowed and should be identified as such. Caddies are not allowed to play golf while caddying.
12. Golf bags, pull carts, and golf carts must be kept off tees, greens and aprons. Golf carts must follow all signs, and directions and follow paths where provided, (NO EXCEPTIONS).
13. The golf course may be closed for designated tournaments or golf course maintenance at the discretion of the Parks, Recreation and Cemetery Division. All players must yield to anyone who is working on the course.
14. Junior Permits (Age 13 and under) are allowed to sign up for tee times 2 days in advance. Play is permitted Monday through Thursday from 10:00 am to 3:30 PM and after 6:00 PM, unless playing with a parent or guardian. Tee times after 2:00 PM may be limited to a 9-hole game. Players who are 12 years of age and under and/or are Junior novice players will be required to play from the red tee markers. Must be playing with a parent or guardian on Fridays. Tee times for Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays will be permitted starting at 2:00 PM.
15. Intermediate Permits (Ages 14 through 17) are allowed to sign up for tee times up to 3 days in advance and can tee off weekdays, except between the hours of 3:30pm and 6:00 PM, unless playing with a parent or guardian. Tee times for Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays will be permitted starting at 12:00pm.
16. All Junior and Intermediate permit holders must attend (or have attended) the Derryfield C.C. rules and etiquette course. All Junior and Intermediate members are subject to re-attending if deemed necessary by the golf pro.
17. Senior Citizens & College Students will be permitted to play on weekends and holidays starting at 12:00PM. Play before 12:00PM is subject to a green fee.
18. **Season Permit Holders signed the following when their application was accepted:**
I do hereby certify that all information stated is correct. I have read and understand the Policies and Procedures of Derryfield Country Club and agree to adhere to the policies and procedures as stated. I understand any violation could result in the loss of playing and/or golf cart privileges and revocation of my Season Permit.



DISCIPLINE POLICY

It is our intention that all golfers and permit holders adhere to golf etiquette and the rules that have been established by the Derryfield Country Club and the City of Manchester.

Accordingly, we have established the following discipline procedures:

First offense will result in a verbal warning.

Second offense will result in a verbal and written warning, advising that a suspension will be warranted with a third offense.

A third offense will result in a suspension of playing privileges, with a specified length of time.

After returning from a suspension, any offense will result in suspension of playing privileges for the remainder of the season.
